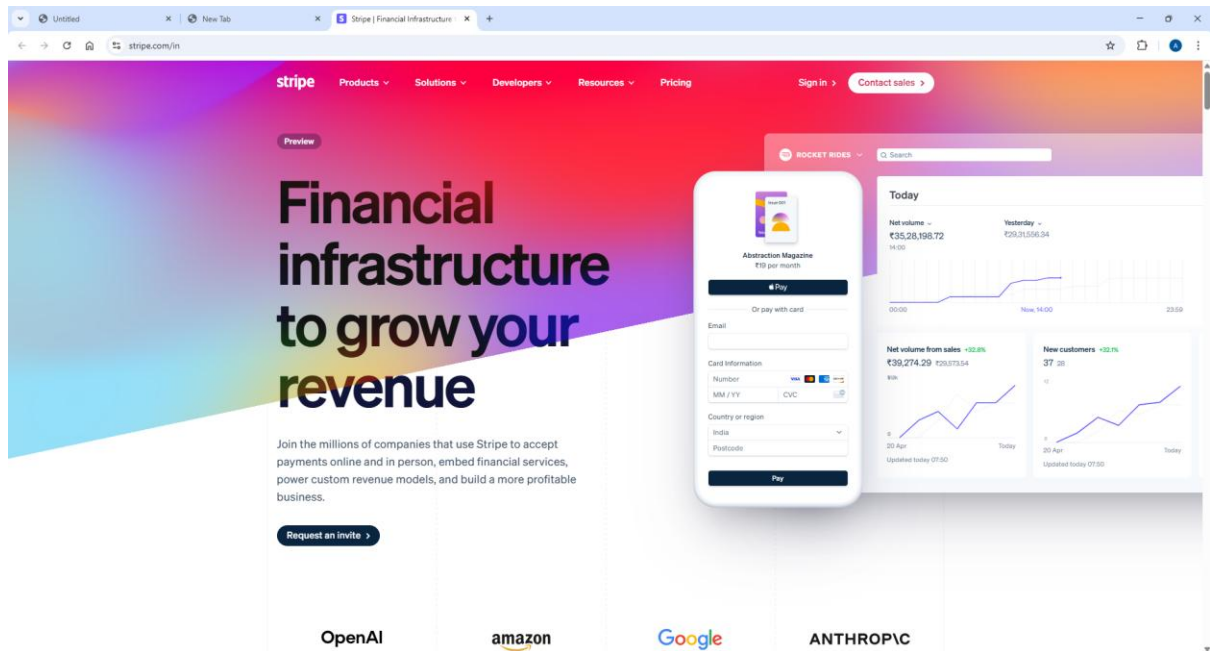
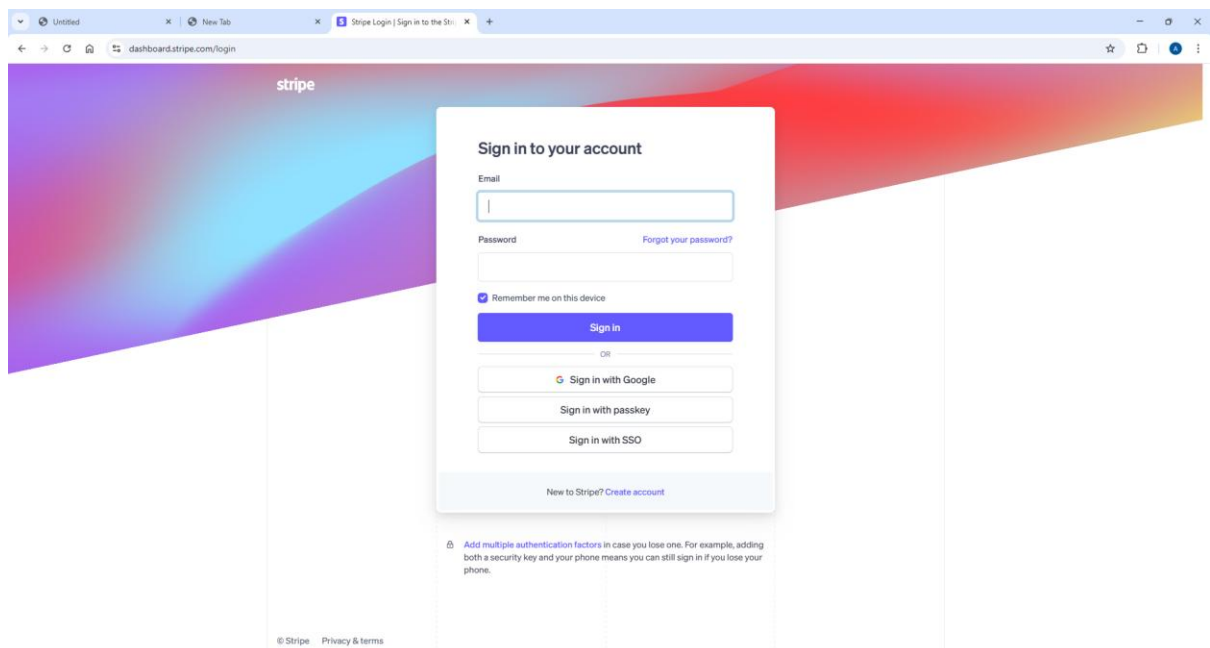


How to get stripe Secret key and Access key




